Early bird nominations closed September 15, 2010 at \$150. Final closing on November 1, 2010 at \$500. \$400 to pass the entry box and \$400 additional to start. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which \$ 60,000 to the winner; \$20,000 to second; \$11,000 to third; \$6,000 to fourth; \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Maidens allowed 5 lbs. (Winners Preferred) Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings. This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. Different owners have equal draw according to money earned. Second choice high earners of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a single entry. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. SU CASA G CASA was ridden along towards the outside, advanced leaving the backstretch, engaged the leader while three wide on the turn, drifted four wide into the stretch, kicked clear while moving a little further out and proved best under strong urging. TORO BRAVO tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid between rivals on the far turn, failed to match strides with the winner in upper stretch and weakened but just held the place. FORT HOOD was ridden along near the back, moved in to save ground on the turn, shifted out outside the furlong marker and finished willingly for the show. PALE BLAZER was well placed just off the pace, drafted behind the leading trio while under some urging on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and capitulated. TONTO TOO broke in a bit at the start, lacked early speed, jostled with STEELY RAN near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced three then four wide on the turn, was guided out in upper stretch and improved position. TOUGH BRUSH was ridden along in the middle of the field, moved in near the half-mile pole, dropped back while off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. PUTITONWAYNESTAB moved in while urged along off the pace, lugged out leaving the backstretch and brushed with TONTO TOO then also failed to respond. OLLIE BABY broke inward at the start, was hard ridden on the outside, chased four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and had nothing left. AMANECER DE ORO was last away, rushed up to take the lead, set the pace under some pressure, vied inside on the turn and gave way. STEELY RAN was urged along while well off the pace, jostled with TONTO TOO near the seven-sixteenths pole, went four then three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. DEELIGHTFUL ANGEL was void of speed, saved ground on the turn and showed little.
