FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED.** Early bird nominations closed September 15, 2010 at \$150. Final closing on November 1, 2010 at \$500. \$400 to pass the entry box and \$400 additional to start. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which \$60,000 to the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: Three Year Olds - 121 lbs. Older - 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2010 allowed 2 lbs. \$36,000 twice at a mile or over in 2010 allowed 4 lbs. Non-winners of three races at a mile or over in 2010 other than maiden, claiming or starter allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2010. This Stake will be limited to 12 starters should race not be split. Different owners have equal draw according to money earned. Second choice high earners of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a singleton try. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Monday, November 1, 2010, with 20 nominations. (Cloudy 70)

Bay Filly, (Feb), by Zarbyev - Ballsbridge by Baldski. Trainer Johnston J. Edward. Bred by Foxwood Plantation, Ltd.(LA).

LADYZARBRIDGE brushed with rivals after the start, went to the early lead, was nicely rated through moderate fractions while off the rail, came under some urging near the five-sixteenths pole, was asked for more at the top of the stretch, came under a right-handed whip passing the three-sixteenths pole, switched leads and drifted in near the furlong marker, responded well when straightened and proved best under strong urging. SUPERIOR STORM brushed with a rival early, raced inside on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, was asked near the three-eighths pole, swung out at the top of the stretch, was put to a right-handed whip, loomed a threat past the three-sixteenths pole, was switched to a left-handed whip in the vicinity of the furlong marker and was second best. LITTLE POLKA DOT brushed with a rival after the start, raced three wide on the first turn, tracked on the outside, chased two to three wide on the far turn and weakened while able to get the show. HARLIE'S DREAMS was last away, raced three then two wide on the first turn, was reserved under good restraint at the back of the field, went four wide while urged along on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and improved position. HISSE was reserved off the pace, came under a ride near the three-eighths pole and failed to respond. THE RUMOR'S TRUE raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn and also failed to respond. OPPORTUNITY LOST raced off the rail on the first turn, lagged near the back of the field, went two to three wide on the far turn and was no factor. NANA KNOWS moved out nearing the first turn, raced three wide on that turn, settled on the outside, chased three to four wide on the far turn and faded.
