6 FURLONGS. (1.08) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 LOUISIANA CHAMPIONS DAY LADIES SPRINT S. FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED. Early bird nominations closed September 15, 2010 at \$150. Final closing on November 1, 2010 at \$500. \$400 to pass the entry box and \$400 additional to start. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which \$60,000 to the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: Three Year Olds- 122 lbs. Older-124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes in 2010 allowed 2 lbs. Non-winners of \$36,000 twice in 2010 allowed 4 lbs. Non-winners of three races other than maiden, claiming or starter in 2010 allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2010. Different owners have equal draw according to money earned. Second choice high earners of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a single entry. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Monday, November 1, 2010, with 28 nominations. (Cloudy 70)

CAJUN CONFERENCE broke awkwardly and was off slow, moved up while off the rail, shifted four wide outside the quarter-pole, rallied in upper stretch, made a bid near the furlong marker and edged clear under strong urging. GOOD HUMAN BEAN chased the pace between rivals, exchanged bumps with SPEEDACIOUS near the half-mile pole, went three wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch, led into the final furlong but was collared then outfinished while just able to get the place. CHERRY FOREVER lacked early speed, raced four to five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to get the show. ANYTHING BUT QUIET was hard ridden towards the rear, raced three wide on the turn and finished willingly but missed the minor awards. CALMED was void of early speed, raced near the rail on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and reached her best stride too late while in the middle of the track. FLAWLESS GOLD sped clear after the start, set the pace near the inside, vied into the final furlong and weakened. THRUTHEGARDENGATE stumbled at the start then bumped with a rival, dropped to the rear, raced off the rail early on the turn, shifted four wide outside the quarter-pole, steadied while blocked behind a wall of horses near the furlong marker, altered course to the outside and finished willingly but lost any chance. SKIPPING TOWN bumped with a rival after the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. SPEEDACIOUS chased the pace, exchanged bumps with GOOD HUMAN BEAN near the half-mile pole, raced off the rail on the turn, steadied a bit while in tight outside the quarter-pole then gave way. WHOOSHOOOO was returned to the paddock for a new rider, dropped off the pace while urged along, raced towards the inside on the turn and failed to threaten. THE PIPSTER steadied in the early going, was forwardly placed on the inside, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. DEBRIS chased the pace on the outside then four to five wide on the turn and capitulated. MORNING MEMORY was ridden along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn and retreated. LADY WILDLEE was urged along on the outside, chased five to six wide on the turn and faded.
