REYNA set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, dug in gamely when challenged near the eighth-pole, battled with SWEET RUSTON in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed. SWEET RUSTON chased the pace on the outside, dropped back a bit leaving the backstretch, raced four wide on the turn, rallied in upper stretch, made a bid passing the eighth-pole, battled with REYNA in the final furlong and was denied. TENSAS PUNCH settled on the outside, moved in leaving the backstretch, raced inside on the turn, waited briefly passing the five-sixteenths pole, moved out at the top of the stretch, shifted further out near the furlong marker and finished well but was too late. LAWYER TIFFANY chased the pace, waited while blocked from the three-eighths pole to the quarter-pole, found room near the inside in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. DO DAT BLUES was last away, moved up after the start, chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn, continued to chase into the final furlong then weakened. CAT'S PRODUCTION was urged along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn, steadied slightly at the top of the stretch, moved out near the furlong marker and improved position. AVERY ROSE was in tight between horses early and dropped back, raced three wide on the turn, swung seven wide into the stretch and failed to rally. TAKE ME HOME TOO pressed the pace on the outside, vied into upper stretch and tired. BURNING CREOLE lacked early speed, raced inside on the turn and was no factor. TIGER GIRL was ridden along on the outside, raced five wide on the turn and came up empty. SWEET JODY broke a tad awkwardly, moved in while off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn and also came up empty.
