6 FURLONGS. (1.08) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 LOUISIANA CHAMPIONS DAY SPRINT S. FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED. Early bird nominations closed September 15, 2010 at \$150. Final closing on November 1, 2010 at \$500. \$400 to pass the entry box and \$400 additional to start. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which \$60,000 to the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: Three Year Olds - 122 lbs. Older- 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes in 2010 allowed 2 lbs. Non-winners of \$36,000 twice in 2010 allowed 4 lbs. Non-w inners of three races other than maiden, claiming or starter in 2010 allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2010. This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. Different owners have equal draw according to money earned. Second choice high earners of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a single entry. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Monday, November 1, 2010, with 18 nominations. (Cloudy 70)

FLASHY WISE CAT settled at the rear of the field then moved inward, raced off the rail on the turn, rallied between rivals in upper stretch, closed strongly under right hand urging, moved out while gaining fast near the sixteenth-pole, accelerated to the lead then powered clear in an impressive effort. MY STAR RUNNER moved out while dueling for the lead, vied two to three wide on the turn, edged clear outside the furlong marker, drifted out a bit near the sixteenth-pole and was overtaken while clear for the place. FOREIGN PRODUCTION dueled on the outside, vied three to four wide on the turn, drifted out near the three-sixteenths pole and weakened while able to save the show. BREAK UP was ridden along while well back in the field, raced off the rail on the turn, moved out nearing the furlong marker and improved position. CANDIANO was last away, passed a few rivals while ridden along, went three to four wide on the turn, moved out a bit once straightened for the drive and failed to rally. TORTUGA STRAITS was ridden along in the middle of the field, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. IDE LIKE A DOUBLE was hard ridden towards the back, raced four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. CAPTAIN BUDDY chased the dueling leaders, raced three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and tired. ZACAROID was ridden along towards the front, raced inside on the turn and dropped out. K J R GIT TYME was ridden along while off the pace, came up empty while inside on the turn and retreated.
