1 1/4 MILES. (1.42) STAKES. Purse \$50,000 *LOUISIANA CHAMPIONS DAY STARTER H. FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED, WHICH HAVE STARTED FOR A CLAIMING PRICE OF \$20,000 OR LESS IN 2010.* Early bird nominations closed September 15, 2010 at \$150. Final closing on November 1, 2010 at \$500. \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start. \$50,000 Guaranteed of which \$30,000 to the winner; \$10,000 to second; \$5,500 to third; \$3,000 to fourth; \$1,500 to fifth. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Weights to be announced on Saturday, December 4, 2010. High weights preferred with second preference to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings in 2010. This Stake will be limited to 12 starters should race not be split. Different owners have equal draw according to weight. Second choice high weight of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a single entry. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Monday, November 1, 2010, with 17 nominations. (Cloudy 70)

Gray or Roan Gelding, (Mar), by On Target - Itsmyturn Todance by Hunting Horn. Trainer Richey J. Tony. Bred by Jarvis Fortier(LA).

GREY PAPILLON brushed with a rival at the start, moved to the early lead, was well rated while off the rail, extended the advantage on the far turn, was asked to pick it up a bit in upper stretch, came under a right-handed whip near the furlong marker and drew off under steady urging to win with authority. NOWANDFOREVERMORE bumped with AUTOBEACAT early, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled in third, was urged along while inside on the far turn and gained the place while no match for the winner. SOUTHERN INVASION brushed with a rival at the start, was eager early on, moved out nearing the first turn, raced three wide on that turn, stalked the leader on the outside, was asked on the far turn, chased into the stretch and weakened then missed the place. WILDRALLY was in tight entering the first turn, raced four then three wide on that turn, was reserved at the back, passed rivals while three then four wide on the far turn, lugged inward nearing the furlong marker and failed to respond. GRAND MINIT raced four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then two wide on the far turn and also failed to respond. AUTOBEACAT bumped with NOWANDFOREVERMORE early then steadied, raced two to three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under a ride while off the rail on the far turn, dropped in near the five-sixteenths pole and had nothing left. EARTHQUAKE was taken back under a strangle hold while on the inside, continued under vigorous restraint while headstrong along the rail, was finally given free rein near the half-mile pole, continued near the inside on the far turn and faltered. AIR COMBAT raced five then four wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went two to three wide on the far turn and also faltered.
