**1 MILE 40 YARDS. (1.382) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 LECOMTE S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.** By subscription of \$100 each (Louisiana Derby early bird nominees automatically subscribed); \$400 to enter; \$500 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$2,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$36,000 allowed 2 lbs.; \$25,000, allowed 4 lbs.; \$20,000, allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. NOTE: This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. Preference to horses according to highest lifetime earnings excluding restricted races at the time of passing entry box. Equibase, Inc. records will be considered official for determining money earned. Different owners have equal draw according to earnings. Second choice high earners of a same owner try receive no consideration over a single entry. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. **THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY.** Closed Saturday, January 9, 2010, with 72 nominations. (Cloudy 65)

RON THE GREEK devoid speed, moved up a bit nearing the drive, swung widest entering the lane, rallied determinedly and got up late.

MAXIMUS RULER set the pace from early on, then while no match for the winner, held second. LETSGETITONMON angled to the inside going to the first turn, was reserved to nearing the second turn, advanced before the drive, split foes nearing the final sixteenth and was gaining late. COOL BULLET forwardly placed three wide around both turn, loomed outside MAXIMUS RULER a furlong out, then had no final kick.

WORLDLY forwardly placed along the inside, lacked a finish. TURF MELODY rank early, raced inside to the second turn, moved out and could make little impact. CITRUS KID unhurried to the second turn, moved out for the drive, then hung. DEPAUL stalked MAXIMUS RULER to upper stretch, then gave way. B'WANAGOLDMINE three wide around the first turn, moved to the inside after entering the backstretch, then was not a factor. ROCK HARD angled to the inside early, then was not a threat.
