1 MILE 70 YARDS. (1.41) STAKES. Purse \$175,000 LECOMTE S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$175 each by Saturday, January 7th. (Louisiana Derby early bird nominees automatically subscribed); \$800 to enter; \$800 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$4,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$175,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$36,000 allowed 2 lbs.; \$25,000, allowed 4 lbs.; \$20,000, all owed 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses according to highest lifetime earnings excluding restricted races at the time of passing entry box. Different owners have equal draw according to earnings. Second choice high earners of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a single entry. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. **THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY.** Closed Saturday, January 7, 2012, with 74 nominations. (Cloudy 75)

MR. BOWLING saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer midway down the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn, made a bid in upper stretch, inched clear into the final furlong and just held under strong urging. Z DAGER was well placed on the inside, came under urging near the five-sixteenths pole, moved out in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed well to just miss. SHARED PROPERTY went four wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, bided his time while three to four wide on the far turn, shifted six wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, loomed a threat into the final furlong and finished willingly but missed. DAN AND SHEILA was in a bit tight entering the first turn, raced three wide on that turn, lagged at the rear of the field, saved ground on the far turn, moved out under the whip in the stretch and finished with good energy. HERO OF ORDER was hustled from the start, raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, made a bid leaving the backstretch, vied into the final furlong and weakened. HAMMERS TERROR went three wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and tired. CAPETOWN DEVIL went four wide on the first turn, settled in the front half of the field, chased five wide on the far turn and capitulated. ALEXANDER THEGREAT raced off the rail while in front on the first turn, drifted out early on the backstretch, set the pace through solid fractions, was challenged leaving the backstretch, vied into upper stretch then gave way. TED'S FOLLY lingered well back in the field while towards the inside, was roused on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, angled out near the three-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. ADENA'S CHANCE saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while two then three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted out some in upper stretch and failed to threaten. EXFACTOR settled off the pace, was roused on the far turn and failed to respond. SEVEN LIVELY SINS was rank into the first turn, raced three wide on that turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn and was no factor. CHALYBEATE SPRINGS went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while five then six wide on the far turn and also failed to respond.
