1 MILE 70 YARDS. (1.41) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 LECOMTE S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$200 by Saturday, January 3. (Louisiana Derby early bird nominees automatically subscribed); \$1,000 to enter; \$1,000 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$5,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$200,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to finishers sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$36,000 allowed 2 lbs.; \$25,000, allowed 4 lbs.; \$20,000, allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Lecomte Stakes will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference to horses with the highest lifetime earnings at the time of passing the entry box. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, January 3, 2015, with 82 nominations. (Cloudy 60)

INTERNATIONAL STAR settled on the inside, was asked on the far turn, followed ANOTHER LEMON DROP coming to the quarter-pole, lacked room behind rivals after turning into the stretch, shifted out at the three-sixteenths pole while put back to urging, shifted further out at the furlong marker, rallied on the outside, closed fast to get the lead at the sixteenth-pole then edged clear under good handling. WAR STORY broke a bit slow, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer while four then five wide on the far turn, rallied to make a bid in upper stretch, battled with TIZNOW R J under a drive, rubbed saddles with that rival while fighting into the final sixteenth then was outfinished while just able to get the place. TIZNOW R J raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, disputed the on the inside of a rival, was taken back off the lead early on the backstretch, moved out entering the far turn, ranged up while three then four wide, made a bid at the top of the stretch, battled with WAR STORY under a drive, rubbed saddles with that rival while fighting into the final sixteenth and was also outfinished then missed the place. ANOTHER LEMON DROP went three then two wide on the first turn, settled towards the front in a good position, ranged up while inside on the far turn, drafted behind the leader late on that bend, made a rail bid with an easy opening at the quarter-pole, brushed the rail while put to a right-handed whip and weakened. SAVOY STOMP was bumped on both sides at the start then pinched back, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled near the back, moved closer while three then four wide on the far turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch and improved position. HERO OF HUMOR bumped with a rival at the start then was hustled, went three then two wide on the first turn, set the pace, lost the lead midway down the backstretch, regained the lead into the far turn, vied in the two path while urged along, lost the lead just after turning into the stretch and tired. EAGLE bumped with RUNHAPPY into the first turn, went five then four wide on that bend, settled well off the pace, was roused while four to five wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. DEKABRIST bumped with an opponent at the start, went four then three wide on the first turn, settled near the back, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn, came out some inside the quarter-pole, drifted in near the three-sixteenths and was no factor. RUNHAPPY bumped hard with rivals at the start, bumped foes on both sides into the first turn, was eager while four wide on that bend, moved up to take the lead midway down the backstretch, lost the lead into the final turn and stopped. KILLINGIT was bumped hard at the start then checked early, went five wide on the first turn, lingered near the back, raced two to three wide on the far turn and never reached contention. FOUR LEAF CHIEF bumped with RUNHAPPY into the first turn, went three wide on that bend, was coaxed along on the backstretch, came up empty in the two path on the far turn and retreated.
