GUEST SUITE went three wide on the first turn, settled nicely in the middle of the field, was roused while three then four wide on the far turn, rallied five wide into the stretch, closed strongly to get the lead at the three-sixteenths, inched clear inside the furlong marker and held under steady urging. UNTRAPPED raced in the two path on the first turn, settled towards the front, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, waited behind horses turning into the stretch, shifted out from behind rivals at the three-sixteenths, chased into the final sixteenth, drifted out late and finished with good courage to get the place. TAKEOFF went four then three wide on the first turn, tracked the leading duo on the outside, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn, advanced to make a four wide bid into the stretch, battled into the final furlong then was outfinished while just able to get the show. ARKLOW broke out at the start, raced inside on the first turn, settled well off the pace, went around the early portion of the far turn in the two path, angled four wide outside the quarter-pole, gained into upper stretch, was carried out late and finished willingly to just miss the show. SHAREHOLDER VALUE bumped with MARCO MISCHIEF nearing the first turn, raced in the two path on that bend, settled towards the back, was asked while three wide early on the far turn, angled five wide late on that bend, gained into the final furlong, was carried out late and also finished willingly but missed the superfecta. PHAT MAN was hustled to the lead, contested the pace on the inside of RUNNING MATE while near the rail, dropped out turning into the stretch and gave way. TIP TAP TAPIZAR brushed with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was asked while three wide on the far turn, dropped to the two path turning into the stretch and failed to rally. MARCO MISCHIEF broke out then brushed with a rival, bumped with SHAREHOLDER VALUE nearing the first turn, went three wide on that bend, settled at the back, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn, spun four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. RUNNING MATE was sent hard from the start, went three then two wide on the first turn, disputed the quick pace on the outside, vied in the two path on the far turn and tired. TOTALITY raced in the two path while rank through the first turn, continued rank for the opening half mile, lagged near the back, was urged along while towards the inside on the far turn and was no factor. PAT ON THE BACK broke out at the start, was eager into the first turn, went five then four wide on that bend, settled on the outside, dropped back under urging in the four path on the far turn and retreated.
