By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination. \$15,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$1,500 to enter and an additional \$1,500 to start, with \$300,000 guaranteed, of which \$180,000 to the owner of the winner, \$60,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth, \$9,000 to fifth and \$6,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 at a mile or over in 2010, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, April 7, 2010 with 41 nominations... EXHI opened clear and controlled the tempo off of the inside, widened his advantage into the stretch and held determinedly to the wire. BUSHWHACKED settled saving ground, commenced a long drive after the opening half, advanced along the inside through the second turn, angled out nearing the quarter pole, came three wide and kept on well but was unable to reach the winner. UPTOWNCHARLYBROWN broke a step slow, was unhurried into stride, shifted out to make his bid, circled seven wide into the stretch, bumped repeatedly with CHIEF COUNSEL through the drive but continued on willingly and was making up ground. CHIEF COUNSEL angled in at once to save ground, worked his way to the outside near the seven-sixteenths pole, came six wide between horses, bumped repeatedly with UPTOWNCHARLYBROWN through the drive and lacked the needed late response. PRINCE WILL I AM was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground, responded when roused with five-sixteenths to run, closed swiftly along the inside, was blocked and steadied entering the stretch, shifted out and split rivals, came again but was left with too much to do. KETTLE RIVER was bumped at the start and allowed to settle, launched his bid circling four wide, ranged into striking distance through the second turn, but weakened between rivals in the drive and faded. DISTORTED DAVE was hustled along off of the inside while never far back, angled in entering the stretch but came up empty in the final furlong and faded. HEAVENVILLE was hustled along four wide to attend the pace, angled in a bit entering the second turn, was caught in traffic near the five-sixteenths marker and flattened out thereafter. KRYPTON was forwardly placed along the inside to the stretch and tired. CONNEMARA was bumped at the start, settled near the tail of the field and lacked a response when called upon. CALL SHOT contended between horses for a half and retreated. LONESOME STREET chased the pace three wide for five furlongs and stopped.
