1 $\frac{1}{4}$  MILES. (1.40 $\frac{1}{4}$ ) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 *COOLMORE LEXINGTON S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS*. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$15,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$1,500 to enter and an additional \$1,500 to start, with \$200,000 guaranteed, of which \$120,000 to the owner of the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$10,000 to fourth, \$6,000 to fifth and \$4,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes at a mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 at a mile or over or two races at a mile or over other than maiden or claiming in 2012, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Coolmore Lexington will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, April 11, 2012 with 49 nominations. (Showery 47)

ALL SQUARED AWAY attended the pace four wide, kept on through a prolonged drive, wrestled control in the final furlong and gamely edged away. SUMMER FRONT was in tight early and lost some position, settled under a snug hold, tugged his way to contention between horses, continued on well five wide but was unable to match strides with the winner. HAMMERS TERROR broke in and bumped with CASTAWAY at the start, recovered quickly and attended the pace four wide, drew to level terms after a half, continued on well through the drive but lacked the needed late punch. GOLD MEGILLAH settled five wide, advanced between horses, finished with a steady advance and improved position. GOLDEN TICKET settled saving ground, got through and loomed a danger entering the stretch but weakened in the drive. HOLIDAY PROMISE was bumped at the start, was unhurried into stride four wide, angled in and moved up through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch and was making up ground late. JOHANNESBOURBON was bumped at the start, was quickly into stride, disputed the pace off the inside, contested the issue to the final furlong and faltered. SKYRING was bumped at the start and allowed to settle, moved up between rivals to make a mild bid but faltered entering the stretch. CASTAWAY was fractious in the gate, was jostled between horses at the start, rushed to contention between horses, contested the pace to the second turn and tired. NEWS PENDING was slow into stride, made an early move six wide, but came up empty before going six furlongs and dropped out. MORGAN'S GUERRILLA was in tight early, was through after a half and was distanced through the stretch.
