**1 1/8 MILES. (1.413) STAKES. Purse \$325,000 COOLMORE LEXINGTON S.(GRADE II) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.** By subscription of \$250 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$16,250 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$1,625 to enter and an additional \$1,625 to start, with \$325,000 guaranteed, of which \$201,500 to the owner of the winner, \$65,000 to second, \$32,500 to third, \$16,250 to fourth and \$9,750 to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 at a mile or over in 2007, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Coolmore Lexington will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners, then those that have accumulated the highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, April 11, 2007 with 40 nominations. (Clear 72)

SLEW'S TIZZY gained the lead while dueling approaching the first turn, raced in the four path under light restraint, opened a clear advantage before going a quarter, edged a bit closer to the inside on the backstretch, was headed for a stride from the rail beginning the far turn by SOARING BY, raced that one into submission nearing the stretch, drew clear, then drifted out a bit under intermittent left-handed urging while increasing his advantage. STARBASE gained a forward position five wide early, tracked the winner from that point on, was asked for his best three furlongs out, then couldn't menace SLEW'S TIZZY in the drive while gamely saving the place. FORTY GRAMS settled near the inside early, raced within easy striking distance, saved ground until the head of the stretch, eased out between foes three wide for the drive, had aim but wasn't good enough. TRUST YOUR LUCK, nicely positioned behind the winner three wide from the first turn on, raced within easy striking distance, worked his way out between foes five wide for the drive and couldn't muster the needed response. JOE GOT EVEN was unhurried while eased back five wide, continued well off the inside around the far turn, was six abreast for the drive when reaching contention but failed to continue. SACRIFICE BUNT, unhurried and four or five wide, was asked for more three furlongs out but failed to respond. SOARING BY, forwardly placed inside from the early on, challenged the winner from the inside upon going a half, headed SLEW'S TIZZY for a stride between calls on the far turn but couldn't sustain the effort. BOOGIEMANBALL was outrun. BELGRAVIA, off the inside, tired after six furlongs.
