By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination; \$400 to enter and \$500 to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$100,000 Guaranteed, of which \$60,000 to the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth and \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: Three year olds, 118 lbs.: Older 123 lbs. Non-Winners of \$45,000 on the turf since May 15, allowed 2 lbs. \$35,000 on the turf since then 4 lbs. \$22,000 on the turf since April 16, 6 lbs.(Maiden,Claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances.) Trophy to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 30th, 2007 with 28 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by man agement not to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five Furlongs). (Clear 87)

SMART AND FANCY, prominent from the outset, finished with good energy to run down the leader in the final furlong and edge clear. **TRULY BLUSHED** broke sharp, saved ground setting the pace and fought it out gamely to the end. **SPANISH LULLABY** showed speed from the outset and finished gamely to just miss for second. **PRIVATELY APPROVED** was outrun through the turn then responded well in the drive. **WILD BERRY** rushed up along the inside rail on the backstretch then lacked the needed rally. **QUEEN AMIRA (GB)** failed to seriously menace. **DAISY FOR RUBIANO** pressed the leader to the stretch then faded in the drive. **CAJUN MISTRESS** was fractious and difficult to load then lacked a rally. **GADGET** showed little. **ON THE RAIL** raced wide. **YODELADYTOO** showed little. Portable inner rail set at zero.
