1 MILE. (Turf) (1.333) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *LOCUST GROVE H. (GRADE III) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing six th through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Saturday, June 26. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of c losing. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Saturday, June 19, 2010 with 47 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One mile.). (Clear 86)

DANZON outrun for a half, moved through traffic with three furlongs to go, came out four wide into the stretch, moved wider for a clear path once in the stretch and closed well to be up in the final stride. HAPPINESS IS pressed the pace three wide, challenged in earnest on the second turn, gained a short lead with a furlong to go but was outfinished. C. S. SILK quick early move to a forward position, raced four wide around the first turn, maintained a forward position into the stretch then rallied to be slowly gaining late. ACOMA within striking distance off the inside, responded in the stretch, challenged inside the final furlong, gained a short lead in deep stretch but was outfinished. KEERTANA reserved four wide, moved in a path while edging closer on the second turn, angled out for the drive and rallied willingly to miss. AWESOME GRANNIE close up along the inside, angled out a bit for the drive, challenged in midstretch, gained a short lead in deep stretch and held on gamely. SWEETEST SONG outrun while in hand, angled out for the drive and closed well. MEADOW SAFFRON within striking distance three wide, moved out to the five path on the second turn and lacked the needed closing bid. LADY'S LAUGHTER five wide on the first turn, moved in a path on the second turn and lacked a late response. WAR TIGRESS set the pace off the inside, held on well to inside the final furlong and tired. WINTER'S CIRCLE close up along the inside, gave way.
