BOB LE BEAU (IRE) saved ground during the initial stages, slipped off the inside route by the eighth hurdle, quickened being put to some hand urging, as did practically all the others during the run around the final bend, shifted inward in preparation for the stretch drive sans the last two jumps, resulting in the runner up getting put into tight quarters, kicked into his best when asked, wrested away the advantage in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, then dug in with good determination to stave off the second place finisher. HINTERLAND (FR) loped along the inside route, was kept on hold drafting behind rivals heading for the top of the lane, got checked when caught in tight quarters midway through the furlong grounds, recovered after the momentary loss of momentum, split rivals rallying at the eighth pole, continued onward with good energy but fell short. DAWALAN (FR) patiently stalked the pacesetter from the two path all the way to the conclusion of the fourth turn, swung four wide for the commencement of the stretch drive, rallied well enough to get up for the show. CHARMINSTER (IRE) saved ground and lacked the needed response. ALL TOGETHER alternated between the two and three paths on the turns, made no headway after being set down entering the stretch. SYROS beat the flag, getting away to a five to six length head start, was rated showing the way from the inside, picked up the pace noticeably departing the backstretch the second time, but wasn't able to shake free, held out on the front end until about a sixteenth remaining before releasing the lead. DIPLOMAT alternated between the three and two paths on the turns, vied with vigor against a pair of opponents to the left on turn four, then gave way. ALAJMAL vacated the inside after making it onto the backstretch for the second time, pressed the issue from between rivals all throughout the going on the final bend, gave way after reaching the start of the flat run stretch drive. An objection lodged by the rider of HINTERLAND against the rider of BOB LE BEAU alleging interference at the top of the stretch was not allowed. THE STETCH DRIVE CONSISTED OF A FLAT RUN IN ITS ENTIRETY.
