GOLD RUSH DANCER was away in good order to press the pace of DEDICATED TO YOU while racing three-wide, moved up to take command nearing the seven-sixteenths marker, opened a clear lead and drew off through the lane with little need of urging. MACH ONE RULES raced four-wide through both turns, settled off the leaders throughout and finished with good energy. DEDICATED TO YOU broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside, relinquished those duties to the winner after going a half, stayed on in the drive and just missed the place. BARKLEY lacked early speed, raced off the rail through the second turn and finished with some late run. POINT PIPER was off a step slow, raced unhurried early, advanced five-wide through the second turn and finished evenly late. STRYKER PHD showed no early speed, raced six-wide through the second turn and did not threaten. SEATTLE SERENADE settled off the leaders early, raced four-wide through the second turn, angled out further into the lane and failed to rally. PAPA FRANK raced off the pacesetters early, moved three-wide through the second turn, angled out further approaching the stretch, raced in tight quarter in mid-stretch and did not menace. CHIEF OF STAFF chased the leaders while racing three-wide and weakened after going six furlongs. BISTRAYA showed brief speed and weakened. TOGRAMMASHOUSEWEGO showed no early speed, raced four-wide through the second turn and was not a factor. BLACK SONA raced off the leaders from the inside, weakened after going a half and was eased through the lane.
