1 1/2 MILES. (Turf) (2.27) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *LONG ISLAND H. (GRADE III) A HANDICAP FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD.* No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$3,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the publication of weights. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$750 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. A trophy will be presented to the winning wner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, October 27, 2012 with 22 7 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile and One Quarter on the Inner Dirt.). (Cloudy 52)

Bay Filly, (Apr), by Dynaformer - Etoile Montante by Miswaki. Trainer Mott I. William. Bred by Juddmonte Farms Inc.(KY).

STARFORMER well rated under restraint while well off the inside in the four path and on the pace, remained patiently handled marshaling the field around the bog until presented an earnest challenge nearing the five-sixteenths, came under urging at that station, swung four wide for home fully roused, dug in determined battling MYSTICAL STAR through the entirety of the stretch holding on in game effort to get the decision. MYSTICAL STAR settled just off the pace three to four wide from the rail behind the cover of the leader, remained rated until three furlongs out, shifted to the two path at that juncture, commenced a bid on the front intensifying the pressure at the five-sixteenths, cornered just off the inside into the stretch, offered up good kick through the lane testing the eventual winner for every step but couldn't go by in a good effort. AIGUE MARINE (GB) allowed to settle at the rear of the compact group in the four path, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, continued four wide in upper stretch, angled out for a clear lane a furlong out, offered up good foot albeit belatedly for the show honors threatening the top two in the last strides. TANNERY (IRE) four deep in mid pack, remained unhurried with the rest of her foes until roused at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide in upper stretch, kicked home with good late foot but was outfinished on the wire while clear of the rest. HIT IT RICH attended the pace maker in closest range of the field from the five path just to that foe's outside, remained on hold and prominent until set down in earnest swinging four wide in upper stretch, weakened in the lane. SENADA crossed to the three path after the start the innermost traveler of the compact group until the three-eighths pole, got let out at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide into the lane, made no impact. KISSABLE (IRE) unhurried from the three path just off the pace, came under coaxing angling to the rail three furlongs out, cut the corner the sole member of the field to be within that close range of the inside throughout, made no late headway through the stretch. THE WEST RIM towards the rear in the four path, raced between rivals TANNERY and SENADA to the half mile pole, came under urging three furlongs out, gave no offer to contend and faded.
