1½ MILES. (Turf) (2.27) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 *LONG ISLAND H. (GRADE III) A HANDICAP FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD.* No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$4,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the publication of weights. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, October 26, 2013 with 22 6 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile and One Quarter on the Inner Dirt.) (Cloudy 48)

INIMITABLE ROMANEE away in good order, took control, was well rated from the rail while laying down moderate splits, with another pair in close attendance both along the outside and on the rail, continued along on the same scenario for the opening mile, stayed comfortably ahead of the same rivals on the last turn, but with each of them now positioned in paths two and three and more energetically-handled, got set down for the drive home, drifted into the two path in mid lane, dug in stubbornly to prevail. TABREED (GB) quickly tucked along the rail, underwent a ground-saving journey, cut the corner already having been put to a drive, displayed good belated energy but fell short. LEFT A MESSAGE patiently tracked the top one sitting in the pocket, got placed into the three path nearing the final turn, was asked for run for the majority of the way around it, but made no progress, did gain a minimal amount leaving the eighth pole to end up a non-threatening third. STRATHNAVER (GB) patiently stalked the winner from the two path, was under some light handing undergoing the task by the top of the final bend, got asked for much more in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, with LEFT A MESSAGE, parked to her outside, already under solid encouragement likewise at that juncture, remained in contention before weakening in the final furlong. WHITE ROSE saved ground until the five-sixteenths marker and failed to menace. AIGUE MARINE (GB) abandoned the inside route departing the second turn, continued from off the rail thereafter, swung three wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response. SHEPPARD'S PIE raced two wide on all three turns, ducked over to the rail coming to the quarter pole with little left to offer.
