Chestnut Colt, (Feb), by Big Brown - Our Josephina by Tale of the Cat. Trainer Baffert Bob. Bred by Emilie Gerlinde Fojan(KY). DORTMUND content to track dueling leaders from off the rail into and through the backstretch, continued three then four wide into the stretch, was under strong asking from the outside in the drive, edged closer under right hand urging, joined rivals three deep nearing the wire and got the bob decision. FIRING LINE pressured the pacesetter to the second bend, moved up and challenged later on the second turn, hooked up in prolonged duel from outside same rival then between rivals, bumped twice with inside rival through the lane and lost narrow decision. MR. Z was under pressured setting the pace while slightly off the rail, resisted when challenger approaching top of the stretch, came two wide into the lane, fought gamely inside rival, lugged out and bumped FIRING LINE twice in grueling drive and narrowly missed. BENCH WARRANT unhurried from the inside, saved ground into the stretch and finished with some interest. NO PROBLEM chased while outside rival early then two wide, moved up some from the inside to the final bend but failed to sustain effort and weakened.
