1 1/8 MILE. (1:42) STAKES. Purse \$75,000 Louisiana S.FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Saturday, January 2. \$300 to enter; \$300 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to finishers sixth through ninth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 at a mile or over since November 16 allowed 2 lbs, \$25,000 at a mile or over since October 16 allowed 4lbs, \$20,000 of such a race since then allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Louisiana Stakes will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. High weights on the scale will be preferred. Different owners have equal draww according to weights. Horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or the supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

INTERNATIONAL STAR went four wide into the first turn then dropped to the rail, settled off the pace, moved closer while inside early on the far turn, angled three wide late on that bend, rallied five wide into the stretch, made an outside bid at the three-sixteenths, drifted in under a right-handed whip while moving clear inside the furlong marker and prevailed under strong urging. EAGLE broke out at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled nicely on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, made a four wide bid at the quarter-pole, was thrown in by the rider in order to switch leads at the three-sixteenths, achieved success with that maneuver, fought with the winner under a left-handed whip into the final furlong, moved outside that rival after he shook clear and finished with good courage but was second best. RIDE ON CURLIN raced in the two path on the first turn, settled in third position, was coaxed along while inside early on the far turn then eased off the rail, espied an opening between horses turning into the stretch, bumped hard with MAJESTIC HARBOR after getting into that hold, was put in tight by light contact with COUP DE GRACE, bumped extremely hard with MAJESTIC HARBOR multiple times then weakened while some how able to get the show. COUP DE GRACE went three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside under restraint, was let out in the two path on the far turn, drew even with the leader at the five-sixteenths, floated three wide into the stretch, came in slightly and bumped lightly with RIDE ON CURLIN near the three-sixteenths and tired. MAJESTIC HARBOR raced in the two path on the first turn, set the pace through moderate fractions, vied inside on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, bumped with RIDE ON CURLIN after turning into the stretch, bumped extremely hard with that rival multiple times in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths then capitulated. BASHAAR was fractious in the gate, raced inside early on the first turn then came off the rail, settled outside on the backstretch, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to respond. Following the race, the rider of RIDE ON CURLIN claimed foul against EAGLE for alleged interference in the stretch and there was also a stewards' inquiry. After the stewards' review, the claim of foul was disallowed but COUP DE GRACE was disqualified from fourth and placed fifth for interference in upper stretch.
