LATTICE prompted a dawdling pace while saving ground on the turns, challenged the leader from the inside approaching the stretch and proved best under pressure. TRANSDUCTION GOLD set a slow pace while off the inside, moved out in the course on the front and backstretch's, responded willingly when challenged by the winner approaching the stretch and held on gamely. BIRDBIRDISTHEWORD reserved for a mile, advanced inside with less than three furlongs to go, angled out for the drive and closed well. BRASS HAT outrun early, was unhurried to the stretch, came five wide for the drive and closed late gap. SILVERFOOT outrun ealry, advanced three wide after a half then made a good late run. BIGGERBADERBETTER close up while off the inside, lacked a closing bid. SAVE BIG MONEY pressed the pace off the inside and weakened in the stretch. PICKAPOCKET within striking distance, raced five wide on the second turn and had nothing left late. LORD CARMEN outrun ealry, made a good four wide move to the quarter mile marker but faded in the drive. SPIDER POWER (IRE) forwardly placed, moved out four wide on the second turn, held well to the quarter mile marker and faded. FIREROCK BASE unhurried, was eased in the stretch when lame.
