BULLARDS ALLEY was well placed early on, began to make a bid three wide through the backstretch, shifted into the four path entering the lane, took over command in the stretch and drew clear late under a steady drive. JOHNS KITTEN trailed the field early on, shifted into the three path in the final turn, angled out around a wall of foes once in the lane, made a bid late in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. ROMAN APPROVAL chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the final turn, made a bid in the stretch but hung in the final stages. TIZ TOWN stalked the pace early, angled off the rail entering the lane and leveled out late in the stretch run. DYNAMIC SKY pressed the pace early on, shifted into the three path entering the lane, led the field briefly at the top of the lane but weakened late in the stretch drive. WIRELESS FUTURE set the pace from the onset, was on the inside entering the lane and gave way down the stretch.
