Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (May), by Great Notion - Jazz Band by Dixieland Band. Trainer Merryman W. Edwin. Bred by Mr. & Mrs. Edwin W. Merryman(MD).

JAZZY IDEA was angled to the inside nearing the turn, moved closer under some coaxing with five sixteenths remaining, altered out four wide for clear sailing in upper stretch, closed determinedly under solid handling, forged ahead of BEN'S CAT inside the sixteenth pole, switched to her left lead late and was edging away at the wire. BEN'S CAT , taken to rate five wide early, responded when asked and quickly took closer order leaving the far turn, tracked JU JITSU JAX under confident handling around the turn, took over without much encouragement in upper stretch, cleared off inside the three sixteenths marker, met the challenge of the winner with a sixteenth to go but simply could not match strides. NIGHT OFFICER settled back early, saved ground into the lane, angled out and closed between rivals. HEROS REWARD angled off the rail early, stalked the pace around the turn, failed to seriously kick in when roused, drifted out a bit and faded. SUPER CHUNKY , outrun early, swung out wide for the drive and had some belated action. CACTUS SON broke slowly, raced wide and failed to respond. JU JITSU JAX quickly cleared, set a strong pace towards the rail, was overtaken by BEN'S CAT in upper stretch then tired leaving the eighth pole. GREEK WARRIOR exchanged bumps with DEPUTY FLING nearing the turn and gave way. DEPUTY FLING , between rivals early, bumped around with GREEK WARRIOR near the turn then retreated.
