FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination. \$450 to pass the entry box, \$450 additional to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 1% to sixth. Weights: Three-Year-Olds 120 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$70,000 in 2013, allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 once in 2013, 4 lbs.; \$50,000 once in 2013, 6 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). F field will be limited to 10 starters with highest career earnings on the turf in 2012-2013. Horses may be placed on the also eligible list. Trophy to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Thursday September 12, 2013 with 42 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race on the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at Six Furlongs) (Rail at 87 feet). (Rainy 74)

Dark Bay or Brown Gelding, (Apr), by Parker's Storm Cat - Twofox by Thirty Eight Paces. Trainer Leatherbury T. King. Bred by K. T. Leatherbury Assoc. Inc.(MD).

BEN'S CAT settled outside while in range, steadily advanced three wide under a light hold after a half mile, was put to solid right handed encouragement inside the three sixteenths marker, reeled in MR. ONLINE near the sixteenth marker, took command with about fifty yards remaining and held firm while being floated out. MR. ONLINE tracked the leader two wide under rating, bid to challenge nearing the lane, spurted clear in upper stretch, drifted out through the final furlong and battled gamely to the wire. NIGHT OFFICER settled well off the early pace, angled five wide when given his cue approaching the stretch, lugged in advancing in mid stretch, was corrected and kept on willingly to get up for the show. GREEK WARRIOR rated in mid pack, angled three wide making some progress into the stretch, came in under right handed pressure in mid stretch then continued with interest between rivals. AWAKINO CAT saved ground off the early pace, angled out in upper stretch and found his best too late between runners. XMAS SKY was sent clear early, set a quick pace towards the rail, was collared entering the stretch, gave brief resistance then faded in the final furlong. SUPER CHUNKY was sent to contention and angled in, stalked the pace, was under urging mid turn, gave futile chase in upper stretch then was put in close by GREEK WARRIOR near the eighth pole. A P ELVIS settled back between rivals early, angled for the drive but had no response. PRIVATE TUTOR chased towards the inside, angled out into the lane, tired and was protected late. SAINTLY LOVE , off the rail, was not a factor.
