TATE'S LANDING settled nicely three wide while tracking a three pronged pace battle, cruised up four wide well within himself entering the lane to take aim, forged to command when set down with three sixteenths to go, quickly cleared, wandered outward when roused left handed inside the eighth pole, was corrected inside the sixteenth marker and continued to increase his advantage under solid hand urging. STAR MANEUVER rated off the rail, circled four to five wide advancing into the lane, continued a steady progression in mid stretch, flattened out late but did manage to save the place. LUNAR ROCK dropped in early and was taken to rate, moved closer past the three eighths pole, awaited room into the stretch, shifted out, worked his way between rivals and finished with good energy. GAS TANK was steadied between rivals entering the turn, altered out four to five wide in upper stretch and closed willingly while drifting in a bit late. RIP ROARIN RITCHIE attended the pace three wide under a rating hold, briefly kicked clear near the quarter pole, was engaged by the winner soon after, gave brief resistance then faded in the final sixteenth. COACH A. J. , forward the opening furlong, dropped back some leaving the far turn, made a mild run between foes in mid stretch then lacked the needed finish. HAMP , under snug rating two wide just behind the leaders, steadied along when bottled up from the quarter pole to the eighth pole then no chance from there to recover. KEEP MOMMA HAPPY , brushed at the break, lagged back early, circled six wide into the lane but failed to menace. MESA DRIVE saved ground, made progress nearing the lane, was checked along lacking room most of the lane and lost all chance. INDEFINABLE HUMOR set a pressured pace inside two rivals and tired leaving the quarter pole. NICEANDEZ vied between rivals to the head of the stretch then faltered.
