SHINING COPPER broke forwardly and remained prominently placed, got rated in the two path attending SOLEMN TRIBUTE, hitched up more fully to the leader after the half had been reached, continued to be kept in reserve all throughout the run around the second bend, was put to a drive challenging in earnest as the field headed into the stretch, forged to the slimmest of leads during the ensuing furlong, but with just about the entire field close enough to snatch it away, vied with vigor matched up with at least two others during the last furlong, briefly while between rivals, had the rider drop the left rein in the final seventy yards, mustered up good courage nevertheless to prevail. JAY GATSBY unhurried during the initial stages, got sent out into path three coming to the end of the backstretch, scurried into contention with a sustained run on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch under solid encouragement, maintained the momentum and continued to advance towards the ones to catch, was outside a pair in the final stages grabbing place honors with the utmost of determination. FULL MAST isolated from all other equines for several minutes before post time, nonetheless proved to be more than a handful before successfully put into her stall, came away in fine shape, raced from off the inside throughout, kept watch on the pace from the three path on the second bend, spun into the stretch and was set down, shifted out to be four wide by midlane, vied with vigor from between fhe first two finishers for the last few jumps, had to settle for the show. ECTOT (GB) two wide on the opening bend, got guided over to the rail proceeding down the backstretch, was forced to bide time, caught behind some foes approaching the quarter pole, had some but hardly enough room to launch a rally cutting the corner into the lane, had her path widen soon afterwards, responded when given her cue, drawing up strongly to challenge by deep into the furlong grounds, kept up the pursuit to the left of stubborn foes until past the sixteenth pole then weakened. OFFERING PLAN darted over to the inside, abandoned it soon after stepping into the two path, raced between rivals for a good portion of the journey on the far turn, arrived at the top of the lane and was switched over to a drive, made no headway chasing front runners spread out across the track a short distance up ahead. SOLEMN TRIBUTE established control soon after the start, was rated from the inside, prompted by the winner, likewise being rated, continued along under the same set up all the way to the quarter pole, got called upon entering the stretch, top one having mustered up a stiff bid, drifted more onto the two path in the general area of the three-sixteenths pole, fought for the lead from between rivals until approximately a sixteenth to go before weakening. CONQUEST TYPHOON rode the rail, had the rider steady the mount slightly departing the first turn, got jammed up in a blind switch from the quarter pole until the final seventy yards, moved out late then completed the short distance left to the wire having never been asked for run.
