1 1/8 MILE. (Turf) (1:38) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 Fasig-Tipton Lure S. FOR FOUR-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE NOT WON A GRADED SWEEPSTAKE IN 2018. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weights 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2017 allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2017-18 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or State-Bred allowance races at a mile or over in 2018 allowed 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2018 allowed 8 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. INSPECTOR LYNLEY off to a sluggish beginning, was one-paced taking up the chase from path two during the initial stages, continued to bring up the back of the pack after joining up with the others on the backstretch, came to life fanning outward heading home, wound up approximately five wide and took off after the ones to catch, poked a head down in front in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, edged away then dug in to preserve the decision. PROJECTED (GB) remained along the rail after the start, got eased to the outside as three-quarters was being completed, swung four wide into the lane, idled in traffic from the top of the lane to the general area of the sixteenth pole, tipped a bit wider for clearance, was given his cue, flashed late energy to out-finish CONQUEST PANTHERA for place honors. CONQUEST PANTHERA strung out three wide on the first turn, shifted closer to the rail once onto the backstretch, travelled the far turn hand urged, although not of the brisk sort, was given his cue angling four wide into the stretch, forged to the front deep into the furlong grounds, was reeled in about a sixteenth later, flattened out a bit and lost out second late. FORGE (GB) got set up into path two after the start, advanced towards the leader after departing the backstretch, with ZENNOR in tow to the outside, was between rivals taking over as the third fraction was about to be posted, turned for home, still leading narrowly but with others in hot pursuit, held out until a short distance from the eighth pole and weakened. BLACKTYPE (FR) firmly rated in the pocket, tipped to the outside at the head of the stretch, came up empty. ZENNOR mostly in path four on the opening bend, resumed its pursuit more in path three after stepping onto the backstretch, advanced together with FORGE leaving the half mile pole, went by the leader past the five-sixteenths pole, was under a drive entering the stretch, kept up its bid for the next furlong before tiring. MR CUB recovered in short order after bobbling at the start to grab control, cut over to the rail early on the first turn, was forced to fend off a pair of opponents to the outside after entering the far turn, relinquished at the five-sixteenths pole, backed away steadily in the final furlong.
