PAZ THE BOURBON lightly bumped from both sides at the break, travelled mostly four wide on the turn

ZENNA broke two lengths the fastest, was joined by the runner up by the conclusion of the backstretch, showed the way from a slight distrance off the rail feeling some pressure, drifted three wide when put to a drive spinning into the lane, got overhauled by the top one soon afterwards then steadily backed away. CHRISTENING made some contact with PAZ THE BOURBON as the field was sent off and running, pursued the front runners from the three path on the turn and gave way.
