MAIDEN BEAUTY pursued the pace towards path two, got angled four wide entering the turn, chipped away at the deficit during the ensuing

furlong, continued her quest with success, grabbing away the advantage about a sixteenth later, shook free, kept to a ride to the end. TOSSUP squeezed in the shadow of the starting gate, had the pilot resort to some light encourgagement afterwards, was strung out in path five, taking the widest route of all, travelling on the bend, was under a drive stepping into the lane slightly closer to the inside, closed in from the three-sixteenths marker to the eighth pole, despite coming in briefly after one right shot and then lugging in a few jumps later, in this second instance with no stick work involved, forged to a slim lead inside the eighth pole, got reeled in about a sixteenth later, then was kept going well enough to save second. MIDNITESALRIGHT abandoned the rail for path three approaching the top of the turn, contended for control matched up with NATIVE DAWN, got turned loose for the drive home, obtained a narrow lead, got pounced upon by the second place fnisher, yieded, but barely, fought onward but had to settle for the show. SHE'S TROUBLE squeezed right after the field had been sent off and running, took up postion two wide by the end of the backstretch, was put to a firm hold drafting along as number three in line, was maneuvered to the outside leaving the five-sixteenths pole, fanned all the way out to path seven by the completion of the move, mustered up a mild response in the last eighth. ICY LADY was sent over to the rail soon after the start, continued along the inside route after stepping onto the turn, was forced to remain on hold, caught behind NATIVE DAWN from the top of the lane to midstretch, managed to get out towards path two and into some clearance, made no headway. NATIVE DAWN hustled to the top, carrved out pace mostly from the two path, yielded to heavy pressure in upper stretch and faltered. PRINCESS PINKY bumped solidly very soon after the start, took up the chase four wide and placed to brisk urging, tired after going a half. POSITIVELY JEAN came in sharply, bumping into her next door neighbor and leading a couple of others to bump into each other too, underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn and gave way.
