FROSTY MARGARITA out-broke the field and maintained the advantage, cut over towards the inside in time for the beginning for the run

aournd the clubhouse bend, raced at or near the rail all the way to the quarter pole, vastly increased the tempo of the race and her advantage while proceeding down the backstretch, rider applying a firm grip on the reins, was still more than two body lengths in front turning for home, drifted out a

couple of paths or so with under a sixteenth remaining but reached the wire in time to prevail. KATNISS THE VICTOR made light contact with the left side of the starting gate, yet still managed to break about midpack, raced three wide on the first turn, cruised up on the winner about as wide on the second turn, making up some of the real estate lost on the backstretch, got set down for the drive home, appeared to have been staved off

during the ensuing furlong, closed in steadily on the drifting winner afterwards, especially in the final seventy yards, fell short. MECKE'S MADALYN underwent a ground-saving journey and salvaged the show award. MISS KEW sent over to the rail coming to the end of the backstretch, mustered up a mild kick to mainly improve position. BACKWOOD BAY took up the chase from the two path and gave way.

ABSATOOTLY pulled on the bit for most of the straightaway run leading up to the first turn, raced three wde on the far turn and had no rally. FLATWARE strung out three wide on the opening bend, continued from off the inside, was through after going three-quarters and got eased,
