DANCING EDIE chased between foes then inside, bid along the rail in the stretch, gained a short lead in deep stretch and held gamely under urging. LADY GAMER stalked between foes then off the rail, came four wide into the stretch, bid outside and drifted in some in the lane and continued willingly to the wire. STRONG FAITH hopped slightly at the start, settled off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and finished well. MACADAMIA dropped back outside then settled off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and also finished with interest. CLINET (IRE) chased off the rail then between foes, was in tight in upper stretch, drifted out a bit and steadied behind the runner-up in midstretch and was outfinished. SOPHIE'S TROPHY unhurried off the rail, came out in the stretch and improved position. RUNWAY ROSIE between foes early, chased inside to the stretch and did not rally. ITSAWONDERFULLIFE (IRE) pulled her way along inside to duel for the lead, fought back into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. SUPER FREAKY stalked inside then bid between foes and dueled for the lead, fought back into the stretch and also weakened in the final furlong. ATTIMA (GB) chased outside, came five wide into the stretch and weakened, then returned bleeding from the nostrils. FANTASTIC SPRING sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled three deep to the stretch and weakened. A claim of foul by the rider of CLINET against the runner-up for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled both runners contributed to the incident. Rail on hill at zero.
