7 FURLONGS. (1:21) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 Madison S. FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$9,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$1,500 to enter and an additional \$1,500 to start, with \$300,000 guaranteed, of which \$180,000 to the owner of the winner, \$60,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth, \$9,000 to fifth and \$6,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes since November 3 allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade I or Grade II since October 7 or \$60,000 in 2017, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Madison will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen fillies or mares pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest 2016-2017 earnings. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. A silver julep cup will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. Closed Wednesday, March 22, 2017 with 20 nominations. (Clear 52)

PAULASSILVERLINING came out at the start, stalked the pace early along the three path, was between horses through the turn, shifted back out to the three path entering the lane, was under a long drive in the stretch, drifted out and prevailed in the final stages. CONSTELLATION came out at the start, set the pace early from the four path, swung into the six path entering the lane, was under a long drive in the stretch, drifted out down the lane and did not have enough in the final stages. PAID UP SUBSCRIBER was well placed early off the rail, fanned into the seven path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch and was gaining in the late stages. MINES AND MAGIC came out a bit at the start, chased the pace early along the six path, fanned into the seven path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. KATHBALLU vied early on while off the rail, was on the inside entering the lane and weakened late in the stretch drive. WHEATFIELD trailed the field early from the seven path, went into the eight path entering the lane with a belated gain in the stretch. HIGH RIDGE ROAD was bothered a bit at the start, fanned into the seven path in the turn and faded down the lane. PONDER LEA pressed the pace early from the five path, stayed in the five path in the turn and was empty in the stretch run. CLOTHES FALL OFF was done early.
