JOHNNY EVES dueled three deep, took the lead on the turn, inched away into the stretch, drifted out a bit from the whip in the drive but held on gamely. CARRILERO (ARG) chased between horses or a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and gained the place. HORSE GREELEY stalked the pace off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came a bit wide into the stretch, drifted in but held third. HURRY UP AUSTIN settled off the rail then inside, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and found his best stride late. LES GRANDS TROIS chased inside, came around a rival into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and finished with some interest inside. IDIDN'TDOANYTHING chased between horses or a bit off the inside, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. INCRIMINATE wide early, settled outside, came five wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. SILVER STETSON MAN between foes early, chased off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. DIVINE PARK stalked the dueling leaders outside on the backstretch and turn, came five wide into the stretch and also weakened. UNUSUAL SUSPECT settled inside chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail on the turn and outside a rival nearing the stretch and lacked a rally. GREAT HUNTER settled off the pace outside then three deep on the backstretch and turn and did not rally. COBALT BLUE chased between horses then off the rail, angled in for the turn and lacked a further response. E Z WARRIOR had good early speed and dueled between horses, stalked outside a rival leaving the turn and weakened. DESERT CODE went up inside to duel for the lead, put a head in front into the turn, dropped back nearing the stretch and also weakened.
