The purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Any horse that competes in both the Woodford Reserve Manhattan and The Man o' War will have their entry fee waived for the Man o' War. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. Bay Horse, (Mar), by Theatrical (IRE) - Rum Charger (IRE) by Spectrum (IRE). Trainer Clement Christophe. Bred by Mr. & Mrs. Bertram R. Firestone(VA).

WINCHESTER was outrun early, raced far back from outside for seven furlongs, swung six wide at the quarter pole then closed strongly in the middle of the track to get up in the final twenty yards. GIO PONTI was reserved early, saved ground while racing well back for six furlongs, steadied sharply in traffic midway on the turn, moved back to the rail in upper stretch, split horses while gaining rapidly outside the eighth pole, made a strong run to challenge inside the furlong mark, battled heads apart gaining a brief lead in deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. EXPANSION raced in midpack from outside for six furlongs, gained three wide to reach contention on the turn, made a steady run to threaten inside the eighth pole and yielded in deep stretch. TAKE THE POINTS saved ground in good position under a firm hold, rallied inside on the turn, charged to the front opening a clear advantage in midstretch then was bumped between horses while tiring in deep stretch. JUST AS WELL was rated just off the pace, rallied three wide on the turn, rallied between horses in midstretch then steadied in traffic between rivals a sixteenth out. COURT VISION was outrun for six furlongs along the inside, steadied on the rail at the quarter pole, gained inside in midstretch and flattened out. GRAND COUTURIER (GB) trailed to the turn checked in upper stretch and raced in traffic through the final eighth. PINCKNEY HILL saved ground while unhurried for seven furlongs, angled three wide at the quarter pole, took up sharply while challenging in midstretch and failed to threaten thereafter. INTERPATATION pressed the pace for nearly a mile then steadied while giving way approaching the quarter pole. STRIKE A DEAL raced wide for seven furlongs, rallied four wide to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. JET PROPULSION set the pace on the rail to the turn and gave way.
