BRICKS AND MORTAR settled three wide in mid pack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a good kick to take command a furlong from home, edged away under a drive kept to task to the wire. ROBERT BRUCE (CHI) broke a half a beat slow, settled unhurried under rating just off the inside in mid pack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide at the quarter pole, offered up a mild kick to chase the winner home and secure the place honors. RAGING BULL (FR) allowed to settled just off the inside near the rear of the field, remained patiently handled while given some rein to work with three furlongs from home, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, cornered four wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to secure the show honors. CHANNEL MAKER three wide through the first turn, settled just off the pace four then three wide, advanced in tandem with BANDUA on the leader midway on the far turn, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in offering up a mild bid to the eighth pole, then got outfinished in the late stages. CHANNÉL CAT three wide in pursuit from near the rear, came under a ride five-sixteenths from home, angled five to six wide at the quarter pole, improved position by tired rivals in the final eighth. BANDUA established the front early on and showed the way just off the inside, before being displaced by QURBAAN six and a half furlongs from home, waited patiently as that rival shook away midway down the backstretch tracking just off the inside, advanced through the far turn in tandem with CHANNEL MAKER to issue a challenge through the latter portion of the bend, swung two to three wide for home, dug in under a drive taking narrow and brief command just outside the eighth pole, then weakened through the final furlong. OLYMPICO (FR) two to three wide in pursuit from the tail of the field, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, went seven wide into upper stretch and offered no response. QURBAAN hard held along the inside early on, tipped to the two path into the first turn and advanced on the leader, went five paths off the inside into the backstretch pulling on the bit and took over the front six and a half furlongs from home, crossed to the two path spurting away from the field briefly before entering the far turn, came under growing threat from an advancing pair to the outside midway on the turn and was placed to coaxing in response, cut the corner into upper stretch, dug in yielding near the eighth pole, then weakened through to the finish. CATCHO EN DIE (ARG) two to three wide in pursuit early on just off the top pair, came under light coaxing tucking inside half a mile from home, rode the hedge through the far turn, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired.
