Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Apr), by Include - Biscayne Bay by A.P. Indy. Trainer Guillot J. Eric. Bred by Overbrook Farm(KY). OPEN WATER chased outside a rival then briefly between horses on the backstretch, continued outside a foe, went alongside the runner-up on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch, gained the advantage four deep in midstretch and inched away under urging. LADY OF FIFTY tossed her head in a bit of an awkward start, chased outside a rival then briefly three deep early on the backstretch, continued off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch, bid between foes in midstretch, drifted in some, could not quite match the winner but was clearly best of the others. I DAZZLE saved ground off the pace, came out in upper stretch, was three deep a sixteenth out and gained the show. MAKER OR BREAKER angled in and dueled outside a rival, fought back into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. SISTER KATE also angled in and dueled inside, put a head in front on the second turn, fought back to midstretch and also weakened. LADY ASPEN a bit slow to begin, saved ground off the pace, came a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, went outside a rival on the second turn and lacked a response in the drive.
