FILLIES, THREE YEAR OLDS.* No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and \$750 additional to start, with \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally between remaining starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 in 2012 allowed 3 lbs.; \$30,000 at any time allowed 5 lbs.; \$15,000 in 2011 allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered). In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings, excluding money won in restricted races. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Friday, February 3, 2012 with 24 nominees. (Cloudy 32)

AMIE'S DINI broke alertly, settled comfortably behind the leader in the three path while in hand, went after that foe from the outside midway on the final turn, collared her soon after to put a head in front upper stretch, slowly edged clear under steady handling. NOW I KNOW broke in, bobbled, brushed with DEVIOUS INTENT at the start, quickly recovered to move up to set a legitimate pace, continued to show the way into the far turn while still in hand, responded when challenged by the winner, could not match that rival the final furlong, moved out late. LULU WONG unhurried early while outside, made a good gain four wide into contention by late in the final turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive and was unable to match the top two in the final furlong, comfortably clear of the others. COLONIAL EMPRESS void of speed, continued to trail into the far turn, moved to the outside for the drive, managed only a mild rally. DEVIOUS INTENT settled behind the top two inside, continued toward the rail when roused late in the final turn, had little left the final furlong. SOONERETTE off the pace, between rivals in the far turn, failed to respond when asked turning for home.
