**1 MILE. (1.34<sup>2</sup>) STAKES. Purse \$75,000 *MARTHA WASHINGTON S. FILLIES, THREE YEAR OLDS.* No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and \$750 additional to start, with \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally be between remaining starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 in 2013 allowed 3 lbs.; \$35,000 at any time allowed 5 lbs.; \$25,000 in 2012 allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered). In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2013 Kentucky Oaks, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. SISTER GINGER broke with the field, got clear in the first turn, showed the way up the backstretch through a moderate set of fractions, responded when the runner up came alongside late in the final turn, disposed of that one with a sixteenth to run, drew clear again while lugging out in the late going. ROSE TO GOLD broke alertly, forwardly placed and three wide, went after the winner late in the final turn, dueled into the stretch, put a head in front a furlong out, could not match strides the final sixteenth. BROKEN SPELL brushed start, lacked early foot while racing outside, began to advance four wide in the far turn, continued four wide into the stretch, staged a mild rally down the lane to be along for the show. AMERICAN SUGAR raced back off the early pace, advanced three wide into contention far turn, flattened out into the lane, caught late for the show. LIBERTY GIRL jostled at the start, well in hand when near the back along the inside, continued in traffic into the far turn, moved to the far outside for the drive, displayed a modest amount of late interest after the issue had been decided. I AM MISS BROWN lacked speed, raced between rivals through the second turn, lacked the needed response in the drive. CLOUDY IN SANDIEGO in the second flight along the inside, faded. LADY STONEWALL brushed at the start, raced closest to the winner early, was finished after a half.
