By subscription of \$100 each to accompany the nomination closed Thursday, December 17, 2015 with 24 or by supplementary nomination of \$4,000 at time of entry. \$3,000 to start, with \$200,000 guaranteed of which \$120,000 to the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$24,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth and \$4,000 to fifth. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or Grade II stake at One Mile or Over since June 26, 2015, allowed 3 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or Grade II stake at One Mile or Over OR Two Grade III stakes at One Mile or Over since December 26, 2014, allowed 5 lbs. Horses with the highest earnings in non-claiming races will have preference after allowances. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (Clear 60)

OM had speed between foes then pressed the pace outside a rival, stalked just off the rail on the backstretch, bid again outside that one on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch and proved best under a strong hand ride. PERFECTLY MAJESTIC saved ground stalking the pace, came out in upper stretch to loom a threat in midstretch and was clearly second best. VIGILANTE between horses early, was fanned out into the first turn, settled outside a rival, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and edged rivals late for the show. ACCEPTANCE had speed between horses then angled in, set the pace inside, inched away into the backstretch, fought back on the second turn and into the stretch and lost third late. FUELED BY BOURBON angled in and chased outside a rival then between horses into and on the second turn, waited a bit along the inside into the stretch and was outkicked for third. MISTER BRIGHTSIDE (IRE) pulled and steadied into the first turn, stalked outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SOUL DRIVER broke a bit slowly then steadied when squeezed early, was fanned five wide into the stretch, chased outside, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. CRITTENDEN pulled and stalked inside, came out leaving the second turn and between foes into the stretch and weakened. OCHO OCHO OCHO angled in and stalked outside a rival then between foes leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened. IKE WALKER chased three deep then outside a rival, steadied off heels leaving the second turn, came three wide into the stretch, angled in some and also weakened. PROFESSOR BERNs pulled inside then drifted out into the first turn, chased just off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and did not rally.
