inside and was shuffled back nearing the far turn, raced well back to the turn, angled four wide entering the stretch and rallied belatedly.

SOUTHERN TRUTH set the pace on the rail into midstretch and weakened in the final eighth. HEAVENLY LANDING was outrun early after being bumped at the start, split horses while gaining in traffic on the turn, angled four wide entering the stretch and closed late from outside.

DASHING DEBBY stumbled at the start and failed to threaten thereafter. SPEIGHTFUL LADY raced wide through while being outrun.
