6 FURLONGS. (1.073) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 *MATRON S. (GRADE II) FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD.* By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken its maiden in a race held at the Aqueduct spring or Belmont spring/summer meetings is eligible to receive a one time \$100,000 bonus should that horse go on to win a graded sweepstake at any NYRA track in 2014. 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$66,000 allowed 2 lbs.; a race, 4 lbs.; maidens, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances.) A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, September 20, 2014 with 26 Nominations. (Clear 58)

Bay Filly, (Mar), by Ghostzapper - Seeking the Silver by Grindstone. Trainer Nevin Michelle. Bred by Vince Scuderi(KY). PAULASSILVERLINING sat reserved in the two path for nearly a half, was forced to be kept on hold awaiting suitable options for the last few strides before arriving at the quarter pole, was given her cue and chose to angle outward, went shoulder to shoulder with EXPRESSIVE HUMOR spinning four wide into the stretch, was straightened away and scampered her way into a strong contending position by the end of the run through the furlong grounds, scooted by a pair of opponents to her inside at the beginning of the final furlong, steadily kicked away, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. SKIPALUTE veered out sharply as the field was sent on its way, has the pilot pull off the nearest opponent, but not in time to prevent solid contact between them, assumed a forward position, pressed the issue as the widest of a threesome on the turn, undertaking the chore from the three path, got set down for the drive, almost battled her way to the front by the conclusion of the next furlong, continued onward gamely en route for the place. EVRYBDYMSTGETSTONZ broke on top and maintained the advantage, was pulling on the bit settling along the inside route approaching the end of the backstretch, was forced to fend off a twosome parked to her outside on the turn, got switched over to a drive entering the stretch, put up resistance before yielding with slightly more than an eighth to go, weakened into the show slot. SAVE ROCK AND ROLL underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn, fanned into the six path during the opening stages of the stretch drive, mustered up a mild response to secure the last major check. PARIS BIKINI vied for the lead from between foes on the turn, gave way. DARLING SKY forwardly placed right after the start, was taken back nearing the end of the backstretch, had the rider resort to some encouragement shortly afterwards, faltered off the subsequent ground-saving journey. EMPRESSIVE HUMOR three wide entering the turn, was five wide leaving it, had no rally. DESERT IMAGE bumped by an incoming SKIPALUTE, tipped into the three path after halfway around the turn, made no impact.
