CHARMING KITTEN was nicely rated three wide just off contested early pace, crept up bit closer off the top two leaving the backstretch, edged up to WAR DANCER midway in far turn, continued racing in hand while matching strides with rival into upper stretch, roused at the furlong marker, took on challenge of KAIGUN, dueled for late lead, fought back gamely along inside, refused to be denied and prevailed. KAIGUN was taken in hand and allowed to settle into stalking position two off the inside, inched up closer and raced between rivals with five furlongs left to run, came under a ride in the final turn, showed mild response then shifted out three wide at top of lane, kicked in gamely and moved up to engage CHARMING KITTEN at furlong marker, dueled gamely along the outside of rival into final strides but could not get by stubborn rival and finished second best. DA BIG HOSS settled racing in hand in early stages then moved up closer along the outside, raced off the top two leaders three furlongs out, was set down for the drive at head of lane, continued in contention along the outside, finished evenly in final sixteenth and dug in to hold show in final strides. ST. ALBANS BOY was unhurried and saved ground along the inside, raced in the back of the pack then angled out couple paths in far turn, split foes at sixteenth pole and finished with good energy to the wire. ROCCIA D'ORO (IRE) saved ground and saved ground racing along the inside, shifted off the inside, dug in two wide in the lane, finished with good interest but was not enough for serious late impact. MANCHURIAN HIGH was unhurried and settled in off the pace, picked up the pace leaving the backstretch, fanned out four wide at top of lane and continued with interest to the wire. WAR DANCER pressed the early pace, edged up and began to match strides along outside of BEYOND SMART, shook free from rival and led the way leaving the backstretch, challenged by eventual winner midway in far turn, fought back into head of lane then came up empty and gaveway. MORNING CALM raced near the back of the field, urged for response along the outside at the quarter pole and failed to kick on in the lane. BEYOND SMART set pressured early pace then challenged and vied along the inside of WAR
