RAIL TRIP stalked the pace off the rail under a rating hold, bid alongside TRES BORRACHOS leaving the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, kicked clear and proved best under a brisk hand ride and a long hold late. SANGAREE was in a good position tracking the pace off the rail, came out some into the stretch and gained the place. CIGAR MAN chased off the inside, came out into the stretch and edged rivals for the show three deep on the line. TRES BORRACHOS sent between horses to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail leaving the second turn and into the stretch, was not a match for the winner in the final furlong and weakened some late but just lost the show. DAKOTA PHONE saved ground chasing the pace, steadied in tight off heels just past the eighth pole and was outfinished for a minor award between foes late. SLEW'S TIZNOW chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. ART CURRENCY angled in and settled just off the rail to the stretch and did not rally.
