All nominees to pay \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start. With \$60,000 to the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$12,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth and \$2,000 to fifth. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a stake of \$60,000 at one mile or over allowed 2 lbs. ; non winners of two races other than claiming at one mile or over, 4 lbs. ; a race other than claiming, 6 lbs. ; such a race at any distance, 8 lbs. Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Apr), by Rock Hard Ten - Emerging Glory by Smarten. Trainer Levine N. Bruce. Bred by Wind Hill Farm(KY).

THE MAILET broke in and bumped a rival, chased just off the rail, went three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, bid outside foes in midstretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole, inched away under left handed urging and held. IN THE SLIPS three deep early, angled in and chased inside, split horses into the second turn, came out into the stretch and again nearing midstretch and finished well. CONNIE AND MICHAEL pulled her way along three deep stalking the early pace, bid outside foes on the backstretch then dueled alongside a rival, inched away and angled in on the second turn, fought back inside leaving that turn and in the stretch, could not quite match the winner in the final furlong and was edged for the place. CAMILLE C sped to the early lead inside then stalked along the rail, re-bid alongside a rival leaving the second turn, battled between horses in midstretch and weakened some late. WHISPERING HUSH broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled just off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FORBIDDEN PARADISE (IRE) pulled between horses early, stalked the pace on the first turn then bid between foes on the backstretch and dueled inside, fell back some along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. JULES J bumped at the start, was between horses early, was fanned out a bit into the first turn then stalked inside, went outside a rival into the second turn and between foes into the stretch and also weakened. FULL MANDATE (IRE) pulled inside then lugged out some and steadied sharply into the first turn, chased a bit off the rail then inside, dropped back into and on the second turn, came out on that turn, gave way and was eased into and through the stretch.
