Dark Bay or Brown Horse, (Mar), by Gulch - Weekend Storm by Storm Bird. Trainer Romans L. Dale. Bred by W. S. Farish & Kilroy Thoroughbred Partnership(KY).

COURT VISION settled back off the pace while removed from the rail, angled out four wide when commencing his run leaving the far turn, was floated out very wide in upper stretch, closed sharply under pressure to take command between rivals with about fifty yards to go then dug in tenaciously to stave off the charge of TURALLURE. TURALLURE was guided to the rail soon after the start and taken to rate well off the early pace, gathered some momentum past the three furlong marker while still in hand, worked out to about the six path into the lane, was floated further out in upper stretch, closed strongly outside the winner and just missed. GOLDIKOVA (IRE) relaxed inside while covered up just off the pace, was steered outward for room in upper stretch, forged past the dueling leaders and briefly went clear inside the eighth pole, met the challenge of the winner inside the sixteenth pole then gave way grudgingly. GIO PONTI saved ground under rating, moved up some in upper stretch, angled out advancing inside the furlong marker, steadied briefly near the sixteenth pole then failed to seriously threaten. MR. COMMONS steadied when rank off the heels of GET STORMY nearing the clubhouse turn, advanced three to four wide mid way on the final turn, was carried out in upper stretch and went evenly the final sixteenth. SIDNEY'S CANDY stalked the pace three wide, moved to challenge for the lead after six furlongs, dueled outside JERANIMO to mid stretch then weakened late. JERANIMO prompted the pace two wide, gained command between rivals in upper stretch, dueled inside SIDNEY'S CANDY to the eighth pole then faded. BYWORD (GB) was steadied behind rivals nearing the first turn, edged up between foes leaving the far turn, was bumped and in tight in upper stretch then lacked a solid finish. ZOFFANY (IRE) saved ground while unhurried early, angled out near the quarter pole, bumped with COURAGEOUS CAT in upper stretch, recovered and finished with interest. STRONG SUIT broke a step slow, was checked off heels while rank approaching the first turn, continued to fight restraint into the backstretch, steadied in upper stretch then lacked a bid. COMPLIANCE OFFICER stalked the pace four wide, took closer order under urging mid way on the final turn, was carried out three sixteenths from home and gave way. GET STORMY angled in when going clear the opening quarter, set the pace inside, took pressure from the half mile marker, held a tenuous advantage to the quarter pole, faltered and was eased late. COURAGEOUS CAT rated close up racing between rivals, continued a forward factor to the head of the stretch, steadied off the heels of GOLDIKOVA in the vicinity of the three sixteenths marker, checked then was bumped when in close causing a chain reaction soon after then gave way. An objection by the rider of COURAGEOUS CAT against GOLDIKOVA for alleged interference in upper stretch was not allowed
