1 1/4 MILE. (1:42) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 Mineshaft H.FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 by Saturday, February 3. \$750 to enter; \$750 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$3,000 will be accepted by 12:00 noon on Thursday, February 8 which shall include all fees. \$150,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to finishers sixth through ninth. Weights: Thursday, February 8. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Mineshaft Handicap will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. High weights on the scale will be preferred. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Saturday, February 3, 2018 with 17 nominations. (Cloudy 82)

THE PLAYER came away in good order, went to the front, set an uncontested pace on the inside with an easy lead, controlled the tempo through the far turn, responded well when asked outside the three-sixteenths, was put to a right-handed whip at the furlong marker, drew off under the whip into the final sixteenth then was placed under a brisk hand ride to the wire while much the best. THIRSTFORLIFE brushed with a rival into the first turn, went four wide on that bend, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, was put to the whip near the three-sixteenths and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. SCUBA brushed with a rival into the first turn then steadied, rounded that bend in the two path under restraint, was reserved off the pace, came under urging while two then three wide on the far turn, gained five wide into the stretch, was put to the whip near the three-sixteenths and just missed the place while able to get the show. FIRST PREMIO went around the first turn in the two path, tracked the solo leader, chased in the two path on the far turn, was driven three wide into the stretch, pursued the winner into the final furlong and proved no match then just lost the trifecta. RICH DADDY brushed with rivals into the first turn, went three wide on that bend, settled off the pace, was ridden along in the two path on the far turn, turned into the stretch under the whip and failed to rally. TEAM COLORS was caught five wide early on the first turn then dropped to the four path, settled on the outside, was urged along midway down the backstretch, came under stronger encouragement while three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. NO DISTORTION was rated inside on the first turn, settled near the middle of the field on the backstretch, came under urging near the half-mile pole, saved ground while ridden along on the far turn, dropped back into the stretch and retreated.
