Partnership(KY) WINTER MEMORIES away in good order, nibbled against the bit while being placed under a good hold soon after the start, acted more

kindly leaving the opening bend, patiently bided her time down the backstretch, entered the far turn from the four path, continued to remain on

hold, was stacked six wide at the head of the stretch, took off with sudden acceleration after being asked for run, surged by the leader coming

to the eighth pole, then drew off with powerful strides while being asked to the end. ARCH SUPPORT saved ground to the quarter pole, found room to maneuver into the two path turning home, then came home willingly to grab the place in the late stages. FANCY POINT broke alertly

and quickly established command, was rated while cutting the fractions slightly off the inside until the quarter pole, was asked for run, nearing the quarter pole, with several gearing up for the stretch run, was no match for the top one's burst of speed, yielding the lead readily, then got

along the inside, but failed to fire after being called upon. TABLE TALKING strung out four wide around the first turn, was forwardly placed for the three-quarters and tired. LE MI GEAUX raced along the outside, swerved out suddenly in upper stretch, got put back on a truer course but lacked a rally. BUTTON GIRL attended the pace from the outside until upper stretch and folded. SLEEPLESS DIXIE underwent a wide journey and tired. SILENT JOY lacked the needed bid. A BRILLIANT IDEA brushed with EXCITED at the start, took the inside route during the early stages, was eased outward leaving the backstretch, swung wide into the stretch, was steadied slightly when bothered by LEMI GEAUX in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, then proceeded to improve position with a mild rally. PLEINE FORME saved ground, entered the lane with clear passage
