1 1/4 MILE. (Inner Turf) (1:38 4) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 Miss Grillo S. INNER TURF FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$2,000 (in addition to the entry and starting fees) can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight, 121 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 4 lbs.; all maidens allowed 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, September 16, 2017 with 23 Nominations. SIGNIFICANT FORM four wide through the opening dog legged turn, settled three wide in aim of the front in hand, was patiently waited with until nearing the quarter pole, angled four wide at that station set down for the drive, rallied with a good kick to overhaul the leader nearing the eighth pole, came out under a near sided stick at that station half a path tightening the lane between her and BEST PERFORMANCE on ORBOLUTION forcing that rival to briefly lean on BEST PERFORMANCE, got quickly corrected under an off sided stick, then held her nearest rivals at bay through the final eighth to the finish kept busy to the end. BEST PERFORMANCE four wide through the opening bend, settled four wide in the clear down the backstretch in mid pack, tucked three wide briefly into the far turn coming under coaxing with three furlongs remaining, angled six wide into upper stretch let out for the drive in earnest, rallied on the outside of ORBOLUTION when that foe was put in tight briefly as SIGNIFICANT FORM came outwards slightly a furlong out and got bumped and leaned on, offered up good energy coming inwards under an off sided stick a sixteenth out nudging ORBOLUTION in behind the aforementioned foe while chasing the winner home to the finish. ORBOLUTION bumped at the start by INDY UNION due to pressure initiated by SOUTHAMPTON WAY breaking outwards, settled three wide in mid pack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied in tandem with BEST PERFORMANCE to her outside, had SIGNIFICANT FORM come out slightly under a near sided stick and leaned and bumped BEST PERFORMANCE briefly in tight a furlong out, ran on through to the finish getting nudged lightly by BEST PERFORMANCE a sixteenth out when outpaced in the very late stages. BRAMBLE QUEEN got bumped at the start by SOUTHAMPTON WAY who broke outwards and in turn bumped INDY UNION into ORBOLUTION, settled unhurried just off the inside near the rear of the field, came under a ride at the three-eighths, angled out six wide at the head of the stretch, kicked on belatedly to secure the last major share. CODRINGTON away forwardly placed inside, eased off into the backstretch to track from just off the pace just off the inside, remained patiently handled until nearing the quarter pole, came under coaxing approaching that station, cut the corner roused into upper stretch in perfect striking position, rallied willingly but was beaten to the punch by the top trio when outkicked by those rivals, then got outfinished late on when beginning to weaken in the very late stages. AFRICA (FR) three wide through the opening bend, grew headstrong under the rating of the rider off heels and among rivals from the seven-eighths through to the half mile pole fighting the rider and tossing her head in protest, finally settled once not in the cover of foes in and around her, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch and improved position by tired foes in the stretch. LIFE TIME CITIZEN established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside, remained patiently handled until set down spinning just off the inside for home, dug in and was overhauled nearing the eighth pole, then tired through to the finish. INDY UNION bumped at the start by BRAMBLE QUEEN and in turn bumped ORBOLUTION due to pressure initiated by SOUTHAMPTON WAY breaking outwards, saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. SOUTHAMPTON WAY broke out at the start bumping BRAMBLE QUEEN into INDY UNION and in turn ORBOLUTION, raced two to three wide in closest aim of the leader, came under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, spun two to three wide for home and tired.
