NOT ABROAD saved ground while not far back, edged closer after a half mile, responded when called upon around the far turn, slipped through inside REGAL WARRIOR to take command mid way on the final turn, edged clear under hand pressure into the stretch then widened while kept to steady left handed encouragement in the final furlong. REGAL WARRIOR broke a step slow, was sent up inside rivals soon after and went clear with a mile remaining, set the pace removed the rail, was joined leaving the far turn, chased the winner through the lane, gave way grudgingly and saved the place. TUJOES settled early while off the rail, made some progress into the far turn, circled four wide under a drive into the lane and rallied mildly. CACTUS CHARLIE stalked the pace three to four wide, failed to kick in when set down around the final turn and gave way. EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH rated close up three wide, came under a ride while between rivals around the far turn, gave futile chase past the five sixteenths marker and faded. IN THE JUICE raced wide and dropped back.
